

The lavette incorporates Wharton's love for Newport's water, sky and beaches, and her preference for classicism in home décor. The handmade mosaic glass floor is a classic bordered design using watery, iridescent Italian mother-of-pearl and aquamarine tiles. Pristine white subway wall tile, a 4" x 8" wavy style, rises to 52". A single row of 1.5" x 8" glass aquamarine listello tile caps the white walls — accentuating the color and iridescent efforts of the floor tiles. The listello tiles are topped by a decorative white captello. The remaining walls are hand-painted and textured in old-world-style Italian glazes.
